Monday Street Dance with Miss Sarah Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3

Miss Sarah completed her training at Northern Ballet school and worked as a professional backing dancer/singer for various artists including Take That and has performed in musicals including Singing in the Rain and Copacabana. For the last 23 years Miss Sarah has been a professional dance teacher and choreographer in Ballet, Tap, Jazz, Musical Theatre and Street Dance. She currently teaches children, adults and vocational students. Miss Sarah says "in my classes the children will learn street dance techniques and
